### **CONDITIONS**

NAMM Anchors: All memorials must be fitted with NAMM approved anchorage, including new and those following refitting.

Qualification: To be eligible for interment in the Ranskill and Torworth cemetery the person being buried or cremated: -

- must have lived in the villages of Ranskill or Torworth; or
- if from a hospital, care, or nursing home, must have lived in Ranskill or Torworth previous to entering the hospital or home; or
- must have been born in Ranskill or Torworth; or
- must have close relatives living in Ranskill or Torworth; or
- must have close relatives buried in the Ranskill and Torworth cemetery.

Close relatives normally means blood relatives and include father, mother, son, daughter, brother and sister. Proof of entitlement to be buried in the cemetery may be requested, if thought necessary.

If there is a dispute as to whether the person involved qualifies as a resident, then the final decision will be taken by the Joint Burial Committee.

Cremated remains may be interred in an existing family grave providing the additional memorial is of a flat plaque type, level with the surrounding grass.
